November Guest Speaker

MAJ (R) Joe. L. Todd USA



MAJ Joe L. Todd was born in Bartlesville, Ok and graduated from Bartlesville College High in 1964, He attended OSU from 1964-1966, then served in the First Calvary Division as a helicopter mechanic and crew chief from 1967-1969 in Vietnam. After his stint in the US Army, Joe graduated with a BA in Anthropology from the University of Oklahoma in 1974. Joe was a member of the US Army Reserve and served in Kuwait and Iraq during Desert Storm with the First Infantry Division – 1991-1992 and served 4 months in Haiti with the 486th Civil Affairs Battalion - 1994

During his time of service, MAJ Todd was awarded the Bronze Star, Air Medal with 4 oak leaf clusters, Purple Heart, Kuwaiti Liberation Medal, Humanitarian Service Award, Vietnam Service, Vietnam Campaign, Army Commendation Medal with 2 oak leaf Clusters and Presidential Unit Citation with the 1st Cavalry Division.

Joe has worked with the Oklahoma Historical Society since 1971 and retired from the Historical Society in 2001. Since 2001 he has volunteered for the Dwight D. Eisenhower Library interviewing WWII veterans and to date has interviewed more than 1200 Veterans. He also volunteers for the Oklahoma Historical Society interviewing Korean, Vietnam, Desert Storm, Iraq and Afghanistan veterans over 2500 so far.

In 1975 he was Awarded Outstanding Young Men in America. In 2007 awarded the Oklahoma Heritage Association Award for the WWII stories in the Examiner-Enterprise.

Recently in 2022, Joe was inducted into the Oklahoma Military Hall of Fame and on 24 Feb 2023 he was proclaimed Veteran of the week at the Oklahoma House of Representatives


