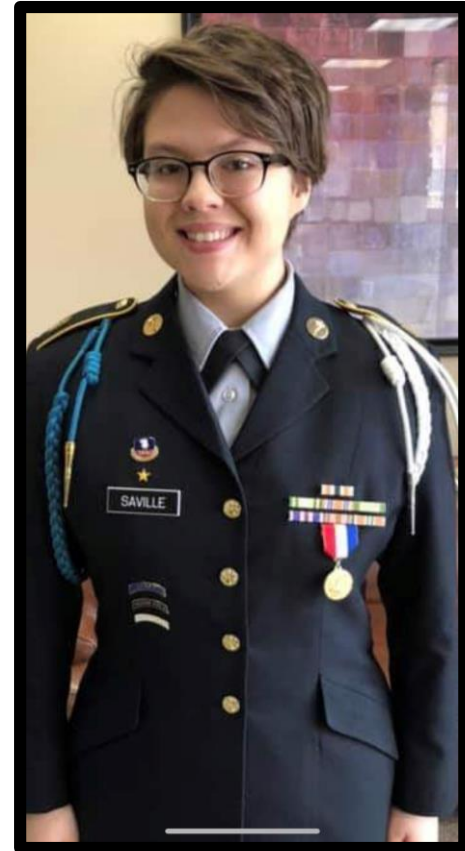
### Rebecca Lynn Saville –Eisenhower High School

- Referee for children in the Altus Soccer Club.



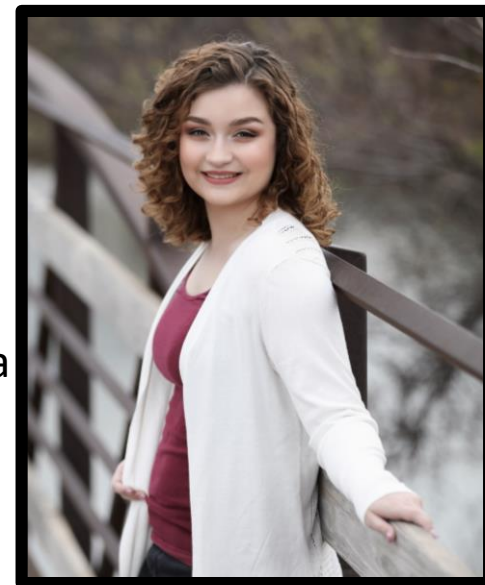
