

Covid 19 Vaccinations—How to Schedule

1. First Dose Vaccine and later Second Dose as a Military TRICARE Over 75 Years. Starting Monday 25 January, TRICARE Beneficiaries age 75 and older will be authorized to receive COVID-19 Vaccines at Reynolds Army Clinic on Fort Sill.

Due to the limited vaccine availability those who fall into the age group MUST make an appointment at Reynolds Army Clinic to receive their vaccination by calling the appointment line at 833-286-3732. Soldiers will have priority for reservations. Appointment slots for age 75 and older are now open and are first come first serve. Call now to make your reservation. You must receive your Second Dose at Reynolds Army Clinic after the specified number of days.

2. First and Second Doses via OSDH: Online [Vaccinate.oklahoma.gov](https://vaccinate.oklahoma.gov) “Covid 19 Schedule Portal” (sponsored by the OK State Department of Health). Currently available for 65 and older.

a. Register. Be prepared to fill out a questionnaire that includes your full name, address, telephone number, and birth date to determine your eligibility. You must be an Oklahoma resident to receive a vaccine at any of the locations in the portal.

b. Receive Email “Covid 19 Vaccine – Book Appointment.” This confirms your registration. Click on [CLICK HERE TO BOOK APPOINTMENT](#). It will offer you vaccinations for locations within a 25-mile radius giving First or Second Doses and prompts you to book an appointment time if available.

c. Receive Confirmation Email with your appointment details.

Health officials say your best bet is to check at the portal at 5:00 pm on Wednesdays because that’s the day Oklahoma receives its doses and determines how many go to respective vaccination locations.

3. Second Dose Notes: If you have already received your First Dose, you must go back to your First Dose provider to schedule your Second Dose and it must be the same vaccine as your First Dose (Moderna or Pfizer). CDC guidance suggests a plus or minus four (4) day window for your second shot.

4. No Access to a Computer. To schedule a vaccination, call the Comanche County Health Department at **580-248-5890**.
